

Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held April 27, 2022, at 9:08 pm at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:

Mayor Bourne called the meeting to order. Council Member Atkinson gave the invocation and Mayor Bourne led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council Member Howell made a motion to approve the agenda. A second was made by Council Member Nelson with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Bourne stated that there was a correction on the minutes. She said in the third paragraph from the bottom there was an extra s on the word orders.

A motion was made by Council Member Nelson to approve the minutes with that change. A second was made by Council Member Atkinson with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Bourne asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. There were none.

Mayor Bourne stated the next item under new business was a vote on audio system purchase.

Council Member Atkinson made a motion to approve the purchase of audio equipment from Robert Egli for the purchase price of \$1,585. A second was made by Council Member Nelson with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Bourne stated we don't have to vote on the next item so no action will be taken on the Municipal Wastewater Planning Program Report.

Council Member Howell made a motion that we approve the annexation of Madsen-Grover Holdings. A second was made by Council Member Nelson with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Council Member Atkinson made a motion that we table the vote on the library blinds until Tate can get us more information. A second was made by Council Member Peacock with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Bourne stated the next item was a vote on a fire truck purchase.

Council Member Peacock made a motion that we table that pending some hard copy bids from both vendors. A second was made by Council Member Nelson with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Council Member Howell made a motion that we approve and move forward with the bid from Deon Miller on updating the new Garland City website. Mayor Bourne commented that she still had some questions for her that she would like to clarify before we vote. Council Member Atkinson made a motion that we table the vote on the webpage until May 4th. A second was made by Council Member Nelson with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Council Member Howell made a motion to approve change order #9 for the sewer plant. A second was made by Council Member Atkinson with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Mayor Bourne asked if there were any financial questions. There were none.

Council Member Nelson made a motion that we go into a closed session to discuss contract and or personnel issues. Steve Brooks, the city attorney commented that he doesn't think we could do it as a contract.

Council Member Nelson restated that she made a motion and roll call vote for a closed session to discuss personnel issues code 52-1-205 (1)(a). A second was made by Council Member Atkinson. The roll call votes as follows:


