

**Minutes of the Garland City Council meeting held August 4, 2021, at 8:04 pm at the Garland City Building with the following council members present:**

**Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. Council Member Peacock gave the invocation and Council Member Bourne led the Pledge of Allegiance.**

**Mayor Miller stated that on the agenda the June 30th minutes were not done so he would entertain a motion to amend the agenda removing those.**

**Council Member Bourne made a motion to amend the agenda by taking 5 b off. A second was made by Council Member Peacock with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated he would entertain a motion to approve the amended agenda.**

**A motion to approve the amended agenda was made by Council Member Bingham. A second was made by Council Member Bourne with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes from June 16th and July 14th.**

**Council Member Bourne noted a correction on the June 16th minutes.**

**Council Member Bourne made a motion to approve the minutes from June 16, 2021 meeting with that change and also the July 14th. A second was made by Council Member Peacock with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller asked if there were any requests for future agenda items. There were none.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the introduction and adoption of Ordinance, O-21-08.**

**A motion was made by Council Member Bourne to approve Ordinance, O-21-08, the curfew ordinance. A second was made by Council Member Ogborn with the roll call vote results are as follows:**

**Mayor Miller stated that under new business was a vote on a side-by-side and small trailer but Matt Cutler was not here so he would entertain a motion to table it.**

**A motion was made by Council Member Bourne to table the vote in the side by side and small trailer. A second was made by Council Member Peacock with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda was the financial review and asked if there were any questions. There were none.**

**Mayor Miller stated the next item on the agenda is the approval of the coding for accounts payable and payroll and utility account adjustments.**

Council Member Bingham made a motion to approve the coding for payroll and accounts payable and utility account adjustments. A second was made by Council Member Ogborn with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.

Under miscellaneous, Mayor Miller stated he had two items. First, don't forget to vote and stated that everyone should have a ballot by now.

The second was to thank Chief Kurt Fertig for everything he has done for the city and for bringing the two police departments together. Mayor Miller presented him with a plaque and a planter.

Council Member Bourne brought up that the weeds behind the library need some attention.

Mayor Miller also brought up that he has the city attorney working on the nuisance ordinance and polishing it up to deal with inoperable vehicles around town.

Matt Cutler came in so Mayor Miller asked him to explain the side-by-side and small trailer item that was tabled earlier in the meeting. Matt stated that the old side by side is currently being sold on the surplus site we use and he wanted to get a couple of new side-by-sides on the government contract and a small trailer to pull behind them. He would like to get a couple of Mules that have the little bed behind them. He thinks we should be able to get two and the trailer for under \$20,000.

Sandy Roundy stated she wanted to thank the city for all their help when she had a bad water leak.

Council Member Bourne asked what the council was going to do for the fair parade. A discussion ensued and they decided to ride with the fire department.

Council Member Peacock made a motion to adjourn at 8:26 pm. A second was made by Council Member Bourne with all council members present voting in favor of the motion.
