Street Improvements/Upcoming Construction

Garland City will be continuing construction on West Factory Street – Phase 2. During this phase, access to West Factory Street will be restricted to farmers and residents who own property there (Road Closed Local Traffic Only signs have been installed), with occasional complete closures of the road. We kindly ask for your cooperation in planning alternate routes and allowing extra travel time during this period. During construction we'll be replacing the underground water lines on West Factory, during this process, there will be intermittent water shut-offs to facilitate the upgrades.
